

Rhyming with the Sneetches

Lesson Originally by Maureen Sullivan

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Need

The Sneetches by Dr. Seuss

Cards with Phonograms on them (Make your own to fit your class)

Tokens

Procedure

Talk about what rhyming means. Ask students if they know any words that rhyme. (Ex Cat, Hat)
Once students understand the concept of rhyming, read *The Sneetches* by Dr. Seuss. Tell the Students to pay special attention to the words that rhyme. Hand out the Phonogram cards to each student, for the game. Read the book as you play. When Students hear a pair of their rhyming words, they should cover them on the card with the tokens. When Students have card covered, they should yell, "Sneetches." Have the student read the words in the text. List on board. Continue reading, and game play, until all have been listed. Talk more about rhyming, focusing on the endings of word/
